<p>Quality (excellence) of the academic profile (CVs) in the specific field of European integration studies.</p> <p>The applicant, seated at University Jean Moulin de Lyon, represents a European group of leading scholars of International Private Law. There cannot be any doubt that there is overall excellence for the performance of the proposed project.</p>

<p>Quality and detail of the planned teaching, research and/or debating activities (with particular attention to the teaching activities in non-EU Member States the academic added value, the multidisciplinary synergies, the innovating character and the openness to civil society).</p> <p>The aim is to study and comment on the evolution of a European Private Law, which demands harmonization with International and National Private Law. It is proposed to organize an international Conference assembling academics and Law practitioners around the topic of the emergence of a European Family Law, and moreover 2 workshops about the relationships between International, National and European Private Law, which aim at gathering Phd students. The program of the Conference is outlined carefully and in detail, showing high competence. Somehow less so for the 2 workshops. The project will result in a fundamental publication. It would have been advisable to involve anglo-saxon specialists in private international law.</p>		
Impact and relevance of the results	22,5	25
<p>Likely impact of the activities on education and/or training at the European level.</p> <p>The results of the project would be largely diffused (via video, publication, podcast). Impact would be on the academic community (doctorants, young researchers, with international linking) as well as Law practitioners, maybe on the evolution of European Private Law itself, and therewith on civil society. It might be argued that an effort to popularize the juridical questions is not foreseen. It is advisable that the results are published in French as well as in English.</p>

Innovative character of the proposal		
The project demands the mastering of different juridical cultures in the aim to propose new European Private Law, which is genuine innovation. The methodical approach first to scrutinize a concrete field of Private Law (Family Law) before entering abstract discussion is original. The applicants had so far no contact with the JM Program.
